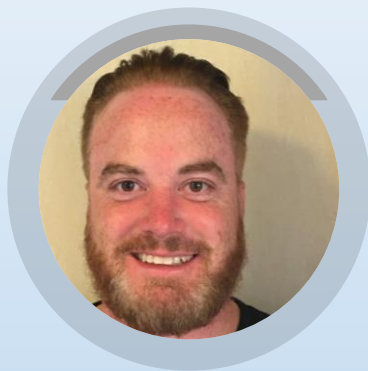

# COSTS

## Section Entry

Beginner, Novice, Intermediate or Adult Premiership Sections = \$50

Open Championship = \$75

Team Sections = \$25

## For dancers entering more than one section:

Beginner & Novice = \$90

Novice & Intermediate = \$90

Adult A & Adult B = \$90

Intermediate & Adult B = \$90

Teams plus any of the above combinations = \$110

Intermediate & Open = \$120

Intermediate & Open plus teams = \$140

## Venue Entry & Other Costs (Pay at the door)

Dance to the Music = \$5

Adults \$12 per day or \$20 weekend pass

Seniors \$10 per day or \$15 weekend pass

Students over 13 years \$10 per day or \$15 weekend pass

Competing dancers & children under 13 = free entry

Results \$5 per copy, Programs \$10

# SECTION CONDITIONS

## BEGINNER PREMIERSHIP



The Beginner section is for dancers in their first year of competition.

Dancers may only wear traditional class costumes or long / short-sleeved blouses / polo tops and skirts / tunics that conform to the regular costume length rules. Low-cut tops and short, tight skirts are not permitted.

Makeup, false eyelashes and tanner on the face is not permitted for dancers up to and including the Under 12 age group.

Results placed to 50% of each group based on total who dance.

Age groups will be determined from entries.

Dancers may enter the Novice Premiership section as well.

Two adjudicators, three rounds. Filming permitted.

The Novice section is for dancers in their second or third year of competition. These dancers have not placed in a Novice or Intermediate three judge event in 2018 (or the equivalent section in their region).

Dancers may only wear traditional class costumes or long / short-sleeved blouses / polo tops and skirts / tunics that conform to the regular costume length rules. Low-cut tops and short, tight skirts are not permitted.

Makeup, false eyelashes and tanner on the face is not permitted for dancers up to and including the Under 12 age group.

Results placed to 50% of each group based on total who dance.

Age groups will be determined from entries.

Dancers may enter the Intermediate Premiership section as well.

Two adjudicators, three rounds. Filming permitted.

## NOVICE PREMIERSHIP

# SECTION CONDITIONS

## INTERMEDIATE PREMIERSHIP



The Intermediate section is for dancers who have not placed in an Open section at a three judge event in 2017 or 2018

This section can also be known as 'Preliminary' in some countries.

Results placed to 50% of each group based on total who dance.

Make-up & tanner on the face not permitted for dancers up to and including the Under 10 age group.

Age Groups 9 years & over to be determined from entries.

Dancers may enter the Open Championship section as well.

Two adjudicators, three rounds. Filming prohibited.

\$50 per dancer

The Ceili & Figure team sections are open to all dancers of all levels.

Under 9, 9 to 13 and Over 13 Age Groups:

- 2, 3 & 4 hand Composed sections (80 bars, including the intro)
- 4, 6 & 8 Hand Commission Book sections
- Open Composed Figure sections, Under and Over 13.

TIDA of NZ and CLRG rules and conditions apply.

Results placed to 50% of each group based on total who dance.

One adjudicator. Some filming permitted – will be announced.

\$25 per dancer for any number of entered teams

# SECTION CONDITIONS

## ADULT A PREMIERSHIP



The Adult A section is for dancers over the age of 18 who did not take Irish dance classes as a juvenile or are over the age of 35 who did not take Irish dance classes after the age of 10.

These dancers are in their first or second year of adult competition.

Dancers may only wear traditional class costumes or long / short-sleeved blouses / polo tops and skirts / tunics that conform to the regular costume length rules. Make-up is permitted. Ladies are required to wear opaque black tights of a denier not less than 70.

Dancers may also enter the Adult B section. Filming permitted.

\$50 per dancer

The Adult B section is for dancers over the age of 18 who did not take Irish dance classes as a juvenile or are over the age of 18 who have taken more than 5 years off with no Irish dance competition.

Dancers can wear a solo costume and make-up. Ladies are required to wear opaque black tights not less than 70 denier.

Dancers can enter this section for no longer than three years.

Dancers may also enter the Intermediate Premiership section.

Filming prohibited.

\$50 per dancer

# GENERAL CONDITIONS

THIS CHAMPIONSHIP IS CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF AN COIMISIÚNN LE RINCÍ GAELACHA AND THE TRADITIONAL IRISH DANCING ASSOCIATION (TIDA NZ)



1) In order for entries to be accepted, teachers must note that all competitors:

a. are pupils of teachers who at the date of entry are registered with An Coimisiún for the year 2018- 2019. New Zealand dancers must be registered with TIDA NZ.

b. must not, on the date(s) of their competitions(s), be ineligible to compete due to any rule.

c. must have been formally entered and have had their entry fees paid in full in due time in accordance with these rules and the general rules of the organising committee.

2) Entries will be accepted from teachers only via [www.feisentry.com](http://www.feisentry.com)

Entries will be open from 5pm Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June until 5pm NZT Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

Late entries will be accepted up until 5pm NZT Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2019, with a late fee of \$25 NZD per dancer.

3) Confirmation of entries received and monies paid will be issued by Feis Entry and forwarded directly to the teacher and organisers.

4) It is the responsibility of the teacher to ensure that the entry submitted online is correct.

When the confirmation email is received, names and dates of birth must be carefully checked. Spelling etc. as submitted by the teacher will be that which appears in the official program.

5) Incomplete entries will not be accepted.

6) No refunds will be made for any entry money received.



THE AGE OF A COMPETITOR SHALL BE TAKEN AS ON 1ST JANUARY, 2019. WHERE A COMPETITOR'S BIRTH DATE FALLS ON 1ST JANUARY HE/SHE SHALL, FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP, BE REGARDED AS UNDER THE AGE ATTAINED ON THAT DAY.
